START-UP FORUM PARTICIPATION

- >> Companies falling under the definition of a Start-Up as per the GSR 127 (E) notification can apply to participate in the SIDM Start-Up Forum.
- >> Existing member Companies of SIDM are eligible to participate in the activities of the Forum.
- >> Start-Ups created as subsidiaries of defence companies can participate in the Forum by taking membership of their holding/parent companies with SIDM.
- >> Participation in the Forum is subject to a fee of Rs. 5000/- plus GST (as applicable) from the date of joining to 31st March. The participation will be renewed on 1st April of every year on payment of applicable Forum Fee.
- Start-Up eligible for SIDM membership will be able to participate in the Forum through the SIDM direct membership only.
- >> Participation in the Forum is subject to approval of the Chairman, SIDM Start-Up Forum and SIDM Membership Committee.
